
## Core reading books. 2024/ 2025


This document shows the core fiction reading books that children will read throughout the year. These books have been chosen to ensure that in their time at All Saints, children have access to a range of authors, illustrators, genres, styles and themes. Some may have links to units of work such as WW2; others have been chosen due the quality of writing, reading age of the children and interests. We have invested heavily in books so that every child from Year 2 onwards is able to have their own copy of all fiction books whilst reading. The excitement when they receive their new book is always a joy to see.

In addition to these books, children will read picture books, poetry and non-fiction books. These may be connected to units of work such as Ancient Egypt or coasts, but they may also be chosen to reflect the interests of the class, an important event/celebration or simply because a child has recommended it.

In Early Years we read pictures books daily as well as in phonics sessions and texts used as a stimulus for writing. This is just a small sample of those we enjoy.





